HB 1 (2018) - Equal Rights Amendment (ERA)

This legislation passed and became part of the Delaware State Constitution in 2019. The Amendment states "Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged on account of sex."

Application: The ERA does not garner rights for women that they do not already have. While presented as mostly symbolic, the intent of the ERA, as expressed by organizations promoting it nationally, is to elevate "sex discrimination" to include the "gender spectrum" which emcompasses gender identity and expression and sexual orientation. On the basis of sex discrimination, it is hoped for by abortion activist groups that the ERA will establish a Constitutional foothold for securing the right to abortion without restrictions and/or provide additional legal support to buttress attempts too restrict abortions.
