HB 320 (2022) - Chemical Abortion Expansion

This legislation was passed in Delaware in 2022. It expands access to prescriptions for chemical abortion by allowing more than just a medical doctor to prescribe the pills. Physician assistants (PA) and advanced practice registered nurses (APRN) -- who are also employed by school-based health centers -- are now allowed to prescribe this pill as well.

Application: By widening the APRN's scope of practice in matters of "reproductive health," may fall under the scope of "reproductive health" that school-based health centers are allowed to provide -- giving minors abortion access at school.
